AGENDA SUBJECT:	Refuse Truck Cab & Chassis for Public Works – Sourcewell Cooperative Contract
INITIATED BY:	Finance Department

It is requested that Council approve the purchase of one (1) refuse truck cab and chassis (2021 Freightliner cab, chassis and complete drive train with installation) for Public Works, from Carolina Environmental Systems, Inc. (Austell, GA), in the amount of \$111,866.00. The purchase will be accomplished by Cooperative Purchase via Sourcewell Contract #091219-THC.

The cab and chassis will be used to replace the cab and chassis of a refuse truck damaged in an accident which totaled the truck cab and chassis, while leaving the truck body (rear hopper) in near perfect condition. The City Manager has approved the purchase. This is replacement equipment.

The purchase will be accomplished by Cooperative Purchase via Request for Proposal (RFP) Contract #091219-THC, initiated by Sourcewell, whereby Heil Environmental was one of the successful vendors contracted to provide Mobile Refuse Collection Vehicles with Related Equipment, Accessories, and Services. The contract, which commenced November 15, 2019, is good through November 15, 2023, with an option to renew for a fifth year at the discretion of Sourcewell. Sourcewell is a Service Cooperative created by Minnesota Statute 123A.21. This statute was created in 1978 and revised in 1995 to allow participating governmental and municipal agencies to reduce the cost of purchased goods by leveraging their combined purchasing power. The RFP process utilized by Sourcewell meets the requirements of the City’s Procurement Ordinance; additionally, cooperative purchasing is authorized per Article 9-101 of the Procurement Ordinance. The purchase will be made through Carolina Environmental Systems, Inc., which is an authorized dealer of Heil Environmental products.

Funds are budgeted in the FY21 Budget: Integrated Waste Management Fund – Public Works – Solid Waste Collection – Heavy Trucks; 0207-260-3510-GARB-7723.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) REFUSE TRUCK CAB AND CHASSIS (2021 FREIGHTLINER CAB, CHASSIS AND COMPLETE DRIVE TRAIN WITH INSTALLATION), FOR PUBLIC WORKS, FROM CAROLINA ENVIRONMENTAL SYSTEMS, INC. (AUSTELL, GA), IN THE AMOUNT OF \$111,866.00. THE PURCHASE WILL BE ACCOMPLISHED BY COOPERATIVE PURCHASE VIA SOURCEWELL CONTRACT #091219-THC.

WHEREAS, the cab and chassis will be used to replace the cab and chassis of a refuse truck damaged in an accident which totaled the truck cab and chassis, while leaving the truck body (rear hopper) in near perfect condition. The City Manager has approved the purchase. This is replacement equipment; and,

WHEREAS, Contract #091219-THC, adopted by Sourcewell, is a cooperative contract available for use by any governmental entity. The City’s Procurement Ordinance, Article 9-101, authorizes the use of cooperative purchasing.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF COLUMBUS, GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase one (1) refuse truck cab and chassis (2021 Freightliner cab, chassis and complete drive train with installation) for Public Works, from Carolina Environmental Systems, Inc. (Austell, GA), in the amount of \$111,866.00, by cooperative purchase via Sourcewell Contract #091219-THC. Funds are budgeted in the FY21 Budget: Integrated Waste Management Fund – Public Works – Solid Waste Collection – Heavy Trucks; 0207-260-3510-GARB-7723.
