New Business:

- **Voter Registration Report-** Diane Scrimshire seconded Edwin Roldan motion to approve 12 obituary deaths for the month of March.
- **General Primary/ Nonpartisan Election Status-** Elections office will notify candidates to view their ballots by providing lists of combos associated with precinct locations.
 - Early voting will begin on April 27th – May 15th 7am to 7pm.
 - 3 Locations for early voting:
 - City Service Center- 3111 Citizens Way
 - Northside Rec Center- 2010 American Way
 - Shirely Winston Rec Center- 5025 Steam Mill Rd
 - Absentee by mail will begin on April 20th.
 - Logic and Accuracy of the voting equipment will begin on April 6, 2026.
 - Council Districts and School Board Districts were the same after reapportionment and redistricting in 2001. Since the school district services, the portion of Ft. Benning in Muscogee County, the representative lines for school board districts are different because of the additional population. The city does not provide city services, so the same population is not included in council districts.



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Old Business:

- **Early Voting Locations-** No new early voting locations will be added for the May 19th election. Board will review other locations after the election. Grant funding received in 2020 provided opportunities for adding additional early voting locations. Three advance voting locations utilizing city owned facilities will be used for the May 19th primary. Columbus Tech will be replaced with Northside Rec center.
