AGENDA SUBJECT:	GDOT/CCG Application for Signalization
AGENDA SUMMARY:	Approval is requested to submit applications to GDOT for operation and maintenance of signals to be installed at the intersections of Veterans Parkway (SR 1/US 27) and Dekalb Drive and Veterans Parkway (SR 1/US 27) and Masse Lane.
INITIATED BY:	Department of Engineering

Recommendation: Approval is requested to submit applications to GDOT (Georgia Department of Transportation) for the operation and maintenance of signals to be installed at Veterans Parkway (SR1/US 27) and Dekalb Drive and Veterans Parkway (SR1/US 27) and Masse Lane.

Background: The signal at Veterans Parkway and Dekalb Drive will be signalized as part of the next phase of the Veterans Parkway Widening Project. The signal at Veterans Parkway and Masse Lane is proposed as part of the Old Town development.

Analysis: CCG will be responsible for operation and maintenance of the signal systems at the two locations.

Financial Considerations: Engineering Traffic Operations Staff in partnership with GDOT will be responsible for general maintenance and operation of the systems. The developer will be responsible for the cost of installation of the signal at Masse Lane and modifications to the existing signal at American Way.

Legal Considerations: Council must authorize the execution of contracts and commitment of City resources.

Recommendation/Action: Approval is requested to submit applications to GDOT (Georgia Department of Transportation) for the operation and maintenance of signals to be installed at Veterans Parkway (SR1/US 27) and Dekalb Drive and Veterans Parkway (SR1/US 27) and Masse Lane.

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF COLUMBUS, GEORGIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO MAKE APPLICATION TO THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (GDOT) FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF TWO SIGNALIZED INTERSECTIONS.

WHEREAS, GDOT as part of traffic studies at the intersections of Veterans Parkway (SR 1/US 27) and Dekalb Drive and Veterans Parkway (SR 1/US 27) and Masse Lane determined signals are warranted; and,

WHEREAS, the City will be responsible for operation and general maintenance of the signalized intersections; and,

WHEREAS, the Developer will be responsible to provide and install signals as part of the Old Town development.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF COLUMBUS, GEORGIA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I.

That the City Manager is hereby authorized to make application to the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) for installation, operation, and maintenance of signalized intersections at Veterans Parkway (SR 1/US 27) and Dekalb Drive and Veterans Parkway (SR 1/US 27) and Masse Lane.
