<u>Recommendation</u>: Approval is requested authorizing the execution of an Encroachment Agreement for the construction of a private sanitary sewer force main within the right of way at 8714 Creekside Drive and along the east right of way line of Trillium Court.

Background: The Department of Engineering has received a request from Sudhir Patel, owner of property at 8714 Creekrise Drive, to construct a private sanitary sewer 2 " force main on the City right of way. The pipe is proposed to cross Creekrise Drive and run along the eastern right of way line of Trillium Court to discharge into an existing manhole at 6001 Trillium Court that is maintained by the Columbus Water Works. CWW has agreed to allow the sewer to be discharged into the existing manhole.

<u>Analysis:</u> An engineered drawing is attached showing the proposed improvements. The City has authorized this type of permanent encroachment in the past. The agreement allows for the construction, repair and maintenance of the private sanitary system. The owner understands the risk of installing a private sewer on the right of way and possibility of damage from utilities or others.

Financial Considerations: There are no financial obligations for the City.

Legal Considerations: Council must approve all permanent encroachments onto public property.

<u>Recommendation/Action</u>: Approval is requested authorizing the execution of an Encroachment Agreement for the construction of a private sanitary sewer force main within the right of way at 8714 Creekside Drive and along the east right of way line of Trillium Court.
