Re: Columbus, GA Renewable Natural Gas - Letter of Support & Intent

Liberty Utilities is providing you this letter to further support our position that Renewable Natural gas is and will be a priority for our national pipeline network. Liberty Utilities has aggressive corporate sustainability goals across all of our operating modalities of natural gas, electricity and water/waste water. This commitment has recently resulted in Liberty Utilities being selected by Corporate Knights as the 10th most sustainable company in the world. Renewable Natural Gas is a key initiative for Liberty to continue on this sustainability path. Liberty has a goal to incorporate renewable natural gas projects in all operational locations within the next twenty four months.

Specifically, to our Columbus operations, we are providing and encouraging interconnection access by the Columbus Power Producers project into our local distribution network. In addition to access, Liberty intends to purchase the RNG produced from the project for two main principles. First, renewable natural gas procured from this project provides Liberty with the ability to serve our customers with the sustainable products they are requesting. Second, this project will provide a meaningful contribution to Liberty's sustainability goals outlined above.

With the mutual memorandum of understanding we have in place between Enerdyne Power Systems and Liberty Utilities we have a clear guideline for the development of the Columbus RNG project. Liberty and Columbus Power Producers are finalizing the definitive agreements which are expected to be executed in the next couple months. In addition, Liberty expects to file with the Georgia Public Services Commission for approval of those definitive agreements in the summer of 2020. Liberty has been working with Enerdyne on this RNG development project for over a year now. The Liberty team has visited some of Enerdyne's operational facilities and have complete confidence in their ability to bring this project to fulfillment. This is a priority for both organizations and one that Liberty is fully committed to. Liberty is excited to partner with Enerdyne Power Systems and the entire Landfill Group in order to provide a solution that satisfies our customers and our company's sustainability goals. We look forward to bringing the Columbus project online to serve our system and customers as soon as possible.
