The purchase will be accomplished by cooperative purchase via Georgia State Contract #99999-SPD-SPD0000218-0001.

The Silverado trucks will be used by Battalion Fire Chiefs in support of their managerial duties. This will facilitate their tasks and ensure timely support across all sites. These are new vehicles.

Georgia State Contract #99999-SPD-SPD0000218-0001 is a cooperative contract whereby Hardy Automotive Fleet is one of the awarded vendors contracted to provide Administrative Vehicles. The term of the contract is good through June 15, 2027. These contracts are available for use by any Georgia governmental entity.
