AGENDA SUBJECT:	Uniform Dress Shoes and Boots (Annual Contract) - RFB No. 22-0003
INITIATED BY:	Finance Department

It is requested that Council approve the purchase of uniform dress shoes and boots, on an "as needed" basis, from Cintas (Columbus, GA) for the estimated contract value of \$115,900.00, Galls, LLC (Lexington, KY) for the estimated contract value of \$65,475.00, and Maneuver Center Supply (Columbus, GA) for the estimated contract value of \$210,541.75, for the annual total estimated contract value of \$391,916.75. The items will be worn by employees in various City Departments.

The initial term of the contract shall be for two (2) years, with the option to renew for three (3) additional twelve-month periods. Contract renewal will be contingent upon the mutual agreement of the City and the Contractor.

Bid specifications were posted on DemandStar, the City's website and Georgia Procurement Registry on July 22, 2021. Bid responses were received on August 18, 2021. This bid has been advertised, opened and reviewed. The bidders were:

²&³Per the bid specifications, "*To accommodate walk-in service on some occasions, the successful bidder shall have a business located within a 25-mile radius of Muscogee County.*" The low bidders were contacted in writing regarding their failure to meet the requirement and given the opportunity to respond. Response(s) from the two vendors were received and provided to the user-Departments for review. Due to constant need for footwear, often on short notice, a locally accessible storefront is necessary to accommodate City employees for sizing and purchases. Therefore, several user Departments have recommended award to the next-lowest responsive bidder. However, both vendors are recommended for award by some Departments.
