BULK WASTE COLLECTION SERVICES IMPACT

- DUE TO COVID: PERSONNEL & EQUIPMENT SHORTAGES
- CDL OPERATORS & FLEET MECHANICS
- AUGUST 2021: AM WASTE BEGAN PROVIDING CONTAINERIZED YARD WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE FOR THE CITY
- TURNED OVER 14 DAILY ROUTES TO AM WASTE (56 WEEKLY)
- AM WASTE COST: \$470,372.00 PER MONTH
- AM WASTE EXPENSES TO DATE \$9,407,440.00 FOR SERVICES

PEAK SEASON WASTE COLLECTION

TIME PERIOD: MARCH 1ST THROUGH OCTOBER 31ST
