AEDs ADDRESS CRITICAL TIME WINDOW

LOCAL AEDs AT COLUMBUS FACILITIES CAN SAVE LIVES



3-5 MINUTES

A person in sudden cardiac arrest should receive a shock within 3-5 minutes for maximum survivability.



911 CONNECTED RESPONSE

Cardiac arrest survival rates decline by 7%-10% for every minute without defibrillation.



EMS DISPATCHED

Our standard AEDs are locked inside our buildings after normal business hours. Outdoor AEDs are accessible 24/7.

AED STEPS



STEPS TO TAKE IN AN EMERGENCY

- Call 911
- Give the location or cabinet ID
- Enter the code
- Grab the AED
- Open the AED
- Listen for Instructions

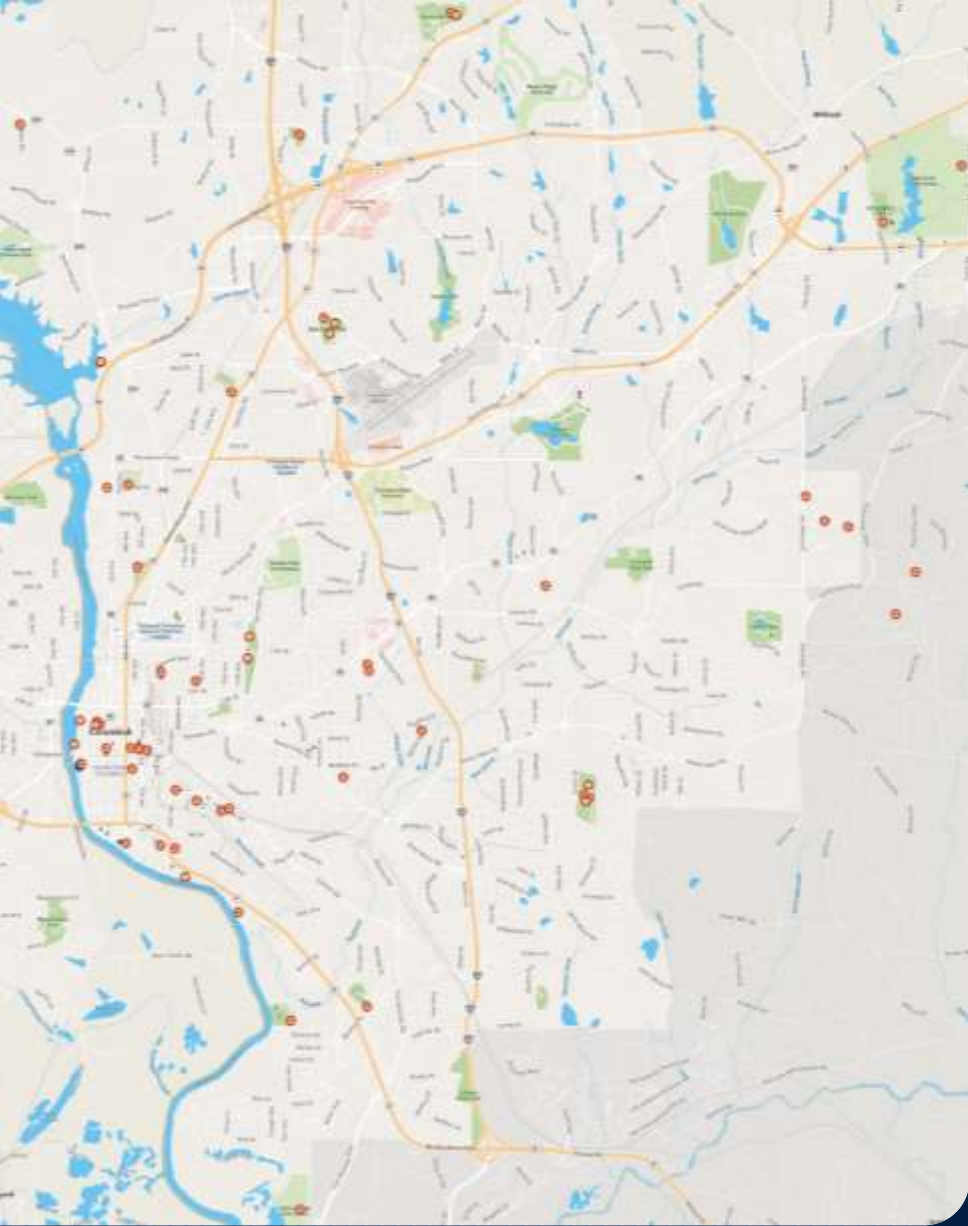
