



River Road Connector



- Single most requested connection from community
- Connects North Columbus residents to Mill District, Uptown, Midtown, & the Fall Line Trace
- Significantly improves safety & accessibility
- Will not affect vehicular commute
- Provides access to high volume of citizens with a relatively small amount of funding
- Fully funded & designed; ready to bid





Funding Sources

Project Cost: \$850,000

- Design & Engineering
 - \$100,000 Dragonfly Trails
- Construction
 - \$183,000 Columbus Water Works
 - \$283,000 Dragonfly Trails
 - \$283,000 City of Columbus

Project is **fully funded**and **ready to bid**with City Council
approval on routing.





Dinglewood Park Connection





- Builds off of existing 33-miles of trail network
- Stakeholder support from Columbus Museum, Housing Authority, MCSD, Midtown Inc., and Property & Business Owners of Villages on 13th
- Connects neighborhoods & trail users to attractions, restaurants, parks, and a grocery store
- Connects Midtown to Uptown Columbus
- Improved Trailhead & Parking





Funding Sources

Project Cost: \$1.4M

- Design & Engineering
 - \$110,350 Dragonfly Trails
- Construction
 - \$200,000 Housing Authority
 - \$200,000 RTP Grant, DNR
 - \$900,000 Dragonfly Trails & City


- includes runner, biker, bamboo, schoal lily
