The purchase will be accomplished by Cooperative Purchase via Federal GSA Contract # 47QTCA19D00MM.

The In-Car Video Camera Systems will be installed in Police vehicles. The camera systems will integrate the three different dash camera systems into one including communication, audio, and video technology. This will enhance officer safety, improve agency accountability, and simplify incident reviews.

The purchase will be accomplished by Cooperative Purchase via Federal GSA Contract # 47QTCA19D00MM awarded to TD Synnex. Prologic ITS is an authorized dealer for TD Synnex. General Services Administration (GSA) is the Federal purchasing cooperative providing products and services for purchase by state and local governments.
