

AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT OF COLUMBUS, GEORGIA
AND
COLUMBUS AIRPORT COMMISSION

This Agreement (the “Agreement”), made and entered into this ____ day of _____, 2026 by and between the Consolidated Government of Columbus, Georgia (“CCG”), and the Columbus Airport Commission, (“CSG”);

RECITALS

Whereas, CCG is a consolidated city-county government existing under the laws of the State of Georgia;

Whereas, the CSG was created by Constitutional Amendment, Article 5, Section 4, Ga. Laws 1868, Page 1655, for the purpose of administering the operations of the Columbus Metropolitan Airport; and,

Whereas, the CSG is in need of operating support to stabilize the airport, building the leadership team to grow non-aeronautical revenue, protect the revenue-producing assets, and pursue strategic initiatives that grow the airport; and,

Whereas, CCG desires to support the efforts of the CSG for ongoing operational needs, capital improvements and deferred maintenance; and,

Whereas, the CCG wishes to assist the CSG with terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement.

WITNESSETH:

In order to carry out the public purposes as set forth above, CCG and CSG hereby agree as follows:

1. The CCG has appropriated an additional \$300,000 in the General Fund for a total of \$340,000. These funds will be distributed 1/12 each month at \$28,333.33 monthly in Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2027 (Fiscal Year 2027).
2. In its Budget for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2027 (Fiscal Year 2027), CCG will appropriate \$900,000 from the TSPLOST Discretionary Funds to be utilized for capital improvements and deferred maintenance (hangers and associated facilities repairs) and will be distributed with the submittal of a quote, bid, or other documentation of specific expenditures. Actual proof of expenditure of funds will follow with copies of checks or disbursement of funds.

3. A detailed expenditure report of how the funds were utilized shall be submitted quarterly to the City Manager.
