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It is requested that Council approve the extension of the annual contract with Peek Pavement Marking, LLC (Columbus, GA) through November 8, 2026, to provide pavement marking services on an “as needed” basis.

The vendor shall provide all materials, supplies, equipment, trained personnel and layout services to cause a satisfactory application of pavement markings in accordance with the Georgia Department of Transportation, the Federal Manual of Uniform Traffic control Devices (MUTCD), or as specified by the Traffic Engineering Manager or his/her agent.

Per Resolution No. 083-20, dated March 24, 2020, Council authorized the execution of a 5-year annual contract with Peek Pavement Marking, LLC. The contract has exhausted all renewals, and a previously authorized extension expired on May 8, 2026. The extension through November 8, 2026, is needed to allow the Engineering Department time to review and revise specifications in order to advertise a new RFB for the next contract.
