AGENDA SUBJECT:	<u>USED & CONFISCATED FIREARMS FOR CREDIT OR SWAP – RFB NO. 26-0035</u>
INITIATED BY:	Finance Department

It is requested that Council rescind Resolution No. 117-26 authorizing the award for Used & Confiscated Firearms for Credit or Swap to Pro Law Enforcement (Prescott, AZ); and **approve award to Proforce Marketing, Inc. d/b/a/ Proforce Law Enforcement (Prescott, AZ)** for Used & Confiscated Firearms for Credit or Swap of three hundred twenty-six (326) used and confiscated firearms from the Columbus Police Department for fifteen (15) Heckler & Koch MRA4 MR556 A4 SBR and accessories. There will be no cost to the City for the swap of the firearms.

Resolution No. 117-26 is required to be rescinded because the vendor’s name was incorrectly stated as Pro Law Enforcement.

The Columbus Police Department is using the swap of the used and confiscated firearms to obtain new weapons for the Department without cost to the City. Per the swap, Proforce Marketing, Inc. d/b/a/ Proforce Law Enforcement will provide the following: fifteen (15) Heckler & Koch MR556 A4 SBR 11” Part No. 81001048 and accessories. The total value of the swap is \$35,161.80.

Bid specifications were posted on the web page of DemandStar, the Purchasing Division, and the Georgia Procurement Registry. Three (3) bids were received on April 1, 2026. This bid has been advertised, opened, and reviewed. The bidders were:

IT IS REQUESTED THAT COUNCIL RESCIND RESOLUTION NO. 117-26 WHICH AUTHORIZED THE AWARD FOR USED & CONFISCATED FIREARMS FOR CREDIT OR SWAP TO PRO LAW ENFORCEMENT (PRESCOTT, AZ); AND AUTHORIZE AWARD TO PROFORCE MARKETING, INC. There will be no cost to the City for the swap of firearms.
