Before the March 24th presidential primary, all Georgia electronic voting machines are required to be replaced with a new voting system that will print paper ballot. With the new system, voters will use a 21.5 inch touchscreen to vote and also use a printer to print their paper ballot. Consequently, each individual voting kiosk must have a method to house the touchscreen, the printer and computer. It has been a challenge for Election officials to find portable storage that can house the equipment needed to vote.

One Georgia County has found a housing/storage rack solution that has been shared with other election officials, which will solve the issue. The Origami 3-shelf small storage rack is portable, foldable and can house the touchscreen, printer, as well as computer unit, all in one-compact solution and still ensure privacy for individual voters.
