Facial recognition technology will allow the department to search criminal watch lists and help conclusively identify a person of interest. Additionally, the department will be able to match a recently taken photo or video against a database of single images in their existing AWARE Mugshot system to help identify that person. This technology will be integrated into the Real-Time Crime Center to expedite intelligence gathering and efficiency of response to situations as they unfold throughout the community.

Per Resolution #162-08, Council approved the purchase of the Afix Tracker System, for the Police Department. Amware acquired Afix Biometric software in 2020. The existing mugs shots in the Afix Tracker System must be imported into the new facial recognition software. Utilizing Amware ensures a seamless integration with the same support team that supports the Afix Tracker system. Consequently, the vendor is deemed an only known source in accordance with the City's Procurement Ordinance, Article 3-114 and Federal CFR 200.320 (c)(2)(4).
