Recommendation: Approval is requested to accept the donation of three (3) Rapid Intervention Team (RIT) kits valued at approximately \$14,285. No local match is required.

<u>Background:</u> Columbus Fire and EMS utilizes a Rapid Intervention Team (RIT) on all working structure fires dedicated to removing a downed firefighter. The RIT pack allows for additional air supply and packaging equipment for the downed firefighter. We currently have two (2) kits in the city and only one at each fire scene. With appropriate unit assignment, the acceptance of this donation will make three (3) of these units available on every scene.

<u>Analysis:</u> Columbus Fire and EMS is seeking permission to accept the donation of three (3) MSA Rapid Intervention Team (RIT) kits for responders in the Operations Division. The use of RIT packs significantly reduces complications when removing a downed firefighter. These units are low-use item but of high value to our personnel when needed.

<u>Financial Considerations</u>: There is no local match required and no foreseen negative budget impact on the city. The donation is valued at \$14,285.

<u>Legal Considerations:</u> None noted.
