

The purpose of this letter of agreement is to define the terms of the Chattahoochee River Conservancy's tributary trash trap program in Columbus, GA.

Chattahoochee River Conservancy ("the Conservancy") agrees to install, maintain, and operate in-stream trash collection devices ("tributary trash traps") on tributaries of the Chattahoochee River that are located within the geographic boundaries of Columbus, GA. This includes but is not limited to the following tributaries: Bull Creek, Lindsey Creek, Cooper Creek and Weracoba Creek.

Columbus, GA, (CCG) a consolidated government agrees to grant access to the Conservancy for the installation, clean out and maintenance of trash traps on tributaries of the Chattahoochee River in locations that are designated by the Conservancy and approved by CCG. At the request of the Conservancy, CCG agrees to assist in the event of debris build up or the accumulation of anything which could damage or harm the trash traps.

Trash traps put in place by the Conservancy are property of the Conservancy and as such, the Conservancy will incur all costs associated with the purchase, installation, clean-out, and maintenance of trash traps.

The Conservancy agrees to clean out the trash traps on a regular basis and make repairs as necessary for the upkeep of the trash traps, and ensure proper disposal of collected items. In addition, the Conservancy agrees to report cleanup events and collection data to the CCG within a reasonable amount of time after such cleanup event. The Conservancy agrees to disconnect or remove any tributary trash traps at the request of CCG. The Conservancy further authorizes CCG to disconnect or remove any tributary trash traps during an emergency situation in the event that arrangements cannot be made by the Conservancy.

The Conservancy will indemnify and hold CCG harmless for any loss, personal injury or property damage associated with the trash trap and their installation or maintenance. The Conservancy will maintain property and liability insurance in terms and amounts acceptable to the CCG Department of Finance with the CCG listed as an additional insured.
