**Recommendation:** Approval is requested for the Mayor, or his designee, to apply for and accept, if awarded, the Homeland Security grant award, in the amount of \$408,137.30, or as otherwise awarded, for the purchase of one law enforcement advanced technology robot, with a local match requirement of \$102,034.33, and amend the multi-governmental fund by the amount awarded.

**Background:** Columbus Homeland Security and Emergency Management is requesting a grant to support the acquisition of the Thermite RS3, a remote-controlled robotic firefighting vehicle developed by Howe & Howe Technologies, as requested by Columbus Fire & EMS. This unit would serve as a regional response platform for high-risk, high-temperature, and life-threatening fire scenarios where traditional operations are either ineffective or unsafe for personnel. Positioned as a special operations resource, the RS3 would directly support local operations in Columbus and Muscogee County, while extending capability to Fort Benning, Columbus Airport, and surrounding counties under existing mutual aid agreements. It would fill a critical gap in modern incident response-combining suppression, reconnaissance, and life safety in one autonomous-ready platform

<u>Analysis:</u> This purchase needs the support of state homeland security funds. This equipment would be used in Muscogee County and be deployable to mutual aid partners as well.

<u>Financial Considerations</u>: This is not a budgeted item, and the 25% match would need to be budgeted once the application is approved.

<u>Legal Considerations:</u> Approval of Council is needed to apply for and accept, if awarded, the State Homeland Security grant, and amend the multi-governmental fund by the amount awarded
