Subject: Amendments to Article 21 and 33

**Recommendation:** Staff recommends planning commissioners to review and fully understand proposed amendments and additions for approval at planning commission and city council level

#### **BACKGROUND ANALYSIS:**

In 2017 The City of Colusa Planning Commission and City Council approved 519 (12F, Article 21 in Zoning Code). At the time of this approval, Cannabis as a legal industry was new to California. In May of this year, the Planning Commission reviewed amendments to 519, thus creating 551, to allow legally approved dispensaries within city limits. As the City, State, and many other municipalities navigate this industry, unforeseen and regulatory updates to City Ordinances, policies, and procedures need to be made. Taking the learnings of the last several years, City staff proposes the attached changes be made to better satisfy the oversight of this industry and ensure enforcement and accountability.
