### **AGENDA ITEM:**

City of Colusa's purchasing policy

**Recommendation:** Adopt Resolution 25-\_\_\_ adopting the updated purchasing policy.

#### **BACKGROUND ANALYSIS:**

The existing Purchasing Policy was adopted on April 17<sup>th</sup>, 2012, and has not been substantially updated since. Changes in procurement laws, evolving organizational needs, and increasing emphasis on fiscal responsibility necessitate a review of current practices.

# **Summary of Proposed Changes**

A preference of up to 5% for qualified local vendors to support economic development.

Clarified language regarding ethical standards and disclosures required by staff involved in purchasing decisions.

Increased dollar amounts to meet the city's current needs.

Removed surplus supplies and equipment

Updated the public works projects language to the current state law

## **Fiscal Impact**

There is no direct fiscal impact from adopting the policy. However, improved procurement practices may lead to cost savings and more efficient use of public funds.
