A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUSA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN AND EXECUTE A STANDARD TRIBAL MONITORING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF COLUSA AND THE CACHIL DEHE BAND OF WINTUN INDIANS OF THE COLUSA INDIAN COMMUNITY COUNCIL FOR THE WESCOTT ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, The City of Colusa periodically performs or causes to be performed certain infrastructure projects which sometimes involves ground disturbing activities.

WHEREAS, Under AB 52 the City is required by CEQA to provide established a formal CEQA tribal consultation process in PRC section 21080.3.1 et seq., requiring lead agencies to consult with California Native American tribes in specified circumstances (including when a tribe has requested notice of projects within its traditional area).

WHEREAS, The City has and continues to work with the Wintun Indian Tribe and both parties desire to adopt a master services agreement to save time and resources on future projects.

WHEREAS, The Wintun Tribe has presented their Standard Monitoring Agreement for the Cities consideration, attached hereto:

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUSA DOES HEREBY RESOLVE:

- 1.) The City Manger is hereby authorized to sign and execute the attached Standard Monitoring Agreement for the Wescott Road Improvement Project.
