- 4.) Topic: Welcome newest Commissioner, Patty Hickel
- 5.) Topic: State of the Parks report- quick update from all commissioners.

All of the parks are in excellent shape and have been getting plenty of use for practices and games. They have been kept very well maintained.

6.) Topic: Pool Park Report and Improvements

Sadie Ash's year end pool report has been received. The Pool is now shut down for the season and everything is packed and put away. The 2022 season concluded with the Pumpkin Plunge. Winter pool plans include winter repairs, including adding skylights in the restrooms and the swim team room, expanding solar heating, installing deck timers and putting in an auto valve and a new structure. There will be a 6 month pool season in 2023. The Colusa City Pool Board is doing a fantastic job!

7.) Topic: Heritage Tree Process

Commissioner Thomas Roach has been doing excellent job writing in the Pioneer Review highlighting our recreation programs, trees, and the hard work of the City staff.
