

RESOLUTION NO. 26-__

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUSA PAUSING THE PRT COMMISSION AND CREATING A COUNCIL AD-HOC FOR THE PARKS, RECREATION AND TREE COMMISSION TO REVIEW ORDINANCE 500 AND BRING BACK TO COUNCIL FOR FURTHER ACTION

WHEREAS, in 2014, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 500, combining the City's Parks and Recreation Commission with the Tree Commission into the Parks, Recreation and Tree Commission ("PRT Commission").

WHEREAS, given the City's growth, changes in priorities, changes to the make-up of City Council, and the evolution of the City's long-term planning goals, the City Council finds that it is appropriate to reevaluate the structure of the PRT Commission and provisions of the Ordinance No. 500 to ensure that they are in line with the City's current needs and long-term goals.

WHEREAS, the City of Colusa City Council pauses PRT Commission until further notice.

WHEREAS, the City of Colusa City Council creates an ad-hoc committee to review the current structure of the PRT Commission, to reevaluate Ordinance No. 500 for possible revision, to review City Council's goals and objectives related to parks, recreation, and urban forestry, and to develop recommendations for a new five-member commission structure for future Council consideration.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUSA DOES HEREBY RESOLVE:

1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and made part of this Resolution.
2. Approval. The City of Colusa City Council approves the resolution pausing the Parks, Recreation and Tree Commission ("PRT Commission"), and:
3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately.

The City Clerk shall certify the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
