RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUSA AMENDING MEMBERSHIP OF THE MEASURE B CITIZENS OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the City of Colusa established the Measure B Citizens Oversight Committee to promote transparency in the use of Measure B revenues derived from a local sales tax dedicated to infrastructure, parks, recreation, public safety, and tree canopy enhancements; and

WHEREAS, committee members serve four-year terms (2023–2027); and

WHEREAS, broad community participation and guidance are essential to the success of the initiative; and

WHEREAS, the committee is not required to hold a quorum to meet, but ensuring regular participation is essential to sustaining effective oversight; and

WHEREAS, it benefits the City and the Committee to add community members to bolster attendance, continuity, and diverse input.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Colusa

- The membership of the Measure B Citizens Oversight Committee is amended to include up to three (3) additional members, in addition to the currently seated members appointed for the 2023–2027 term.
- New members shall be selected through the existing application and Council appointment process.
- All committee functions, reporting schedules, and transparency requirements remain unchanged.
- This Resolution is effective immediately and will continue through the Committee's current term.

The City Clerk shall certify the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
