Quint 28 is in reserve due to a leak in the hydraulic lifting pistons for the aerial / ladder. The pistons have been rebuilt and the apparatus should be back in service Friday, January 9th.

New Quint 28 Update: The vehicle is on the production assembly line at Pierce in Appleton Wisconsin and is moving along rapidly. The projected delivery date is mid-February. NEW Rescue 28 Update: The last email on December 29th 2025 indicated that the vehicle would be moved that week to their Ocala Body Shop to correct paint and associated issues. On Monday, January 5th we sent an email to get an update and a projected date for final inspection. We received a reply on January 7th stating that the rescue was in Ocala where the remaining fire communication equipment and paint corrections. A completion date would be able to be determined next week.


