**NEW Rescue 28 Update:** An acceptance inspection was conducted by the Fleet Manager, Victor Goizueta at our Fleet Service Garage. There were items identified as needing attention and Matheny was notified of these items via email. A date for the follow inspection has not yet been set. Once the identified issues have been addressed and the unit is accepted, BSO Fleet will proceed to mount our equipment on the vehicle, which is forecasted to take roughly 2 - 3 weeks. As previously mentioned, the apparatus' warranty starts when the vehicle responds to the first incident / call for service.

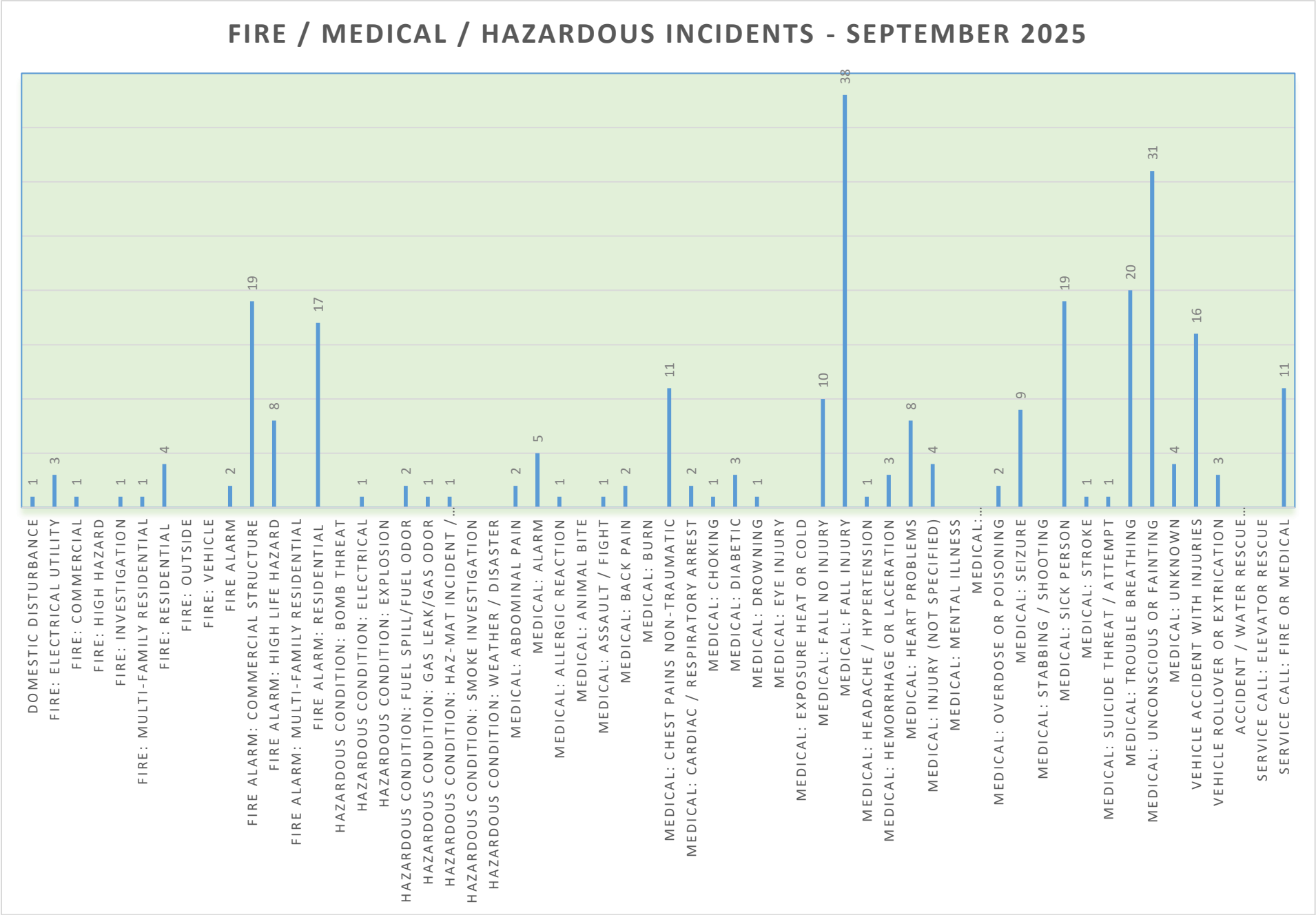

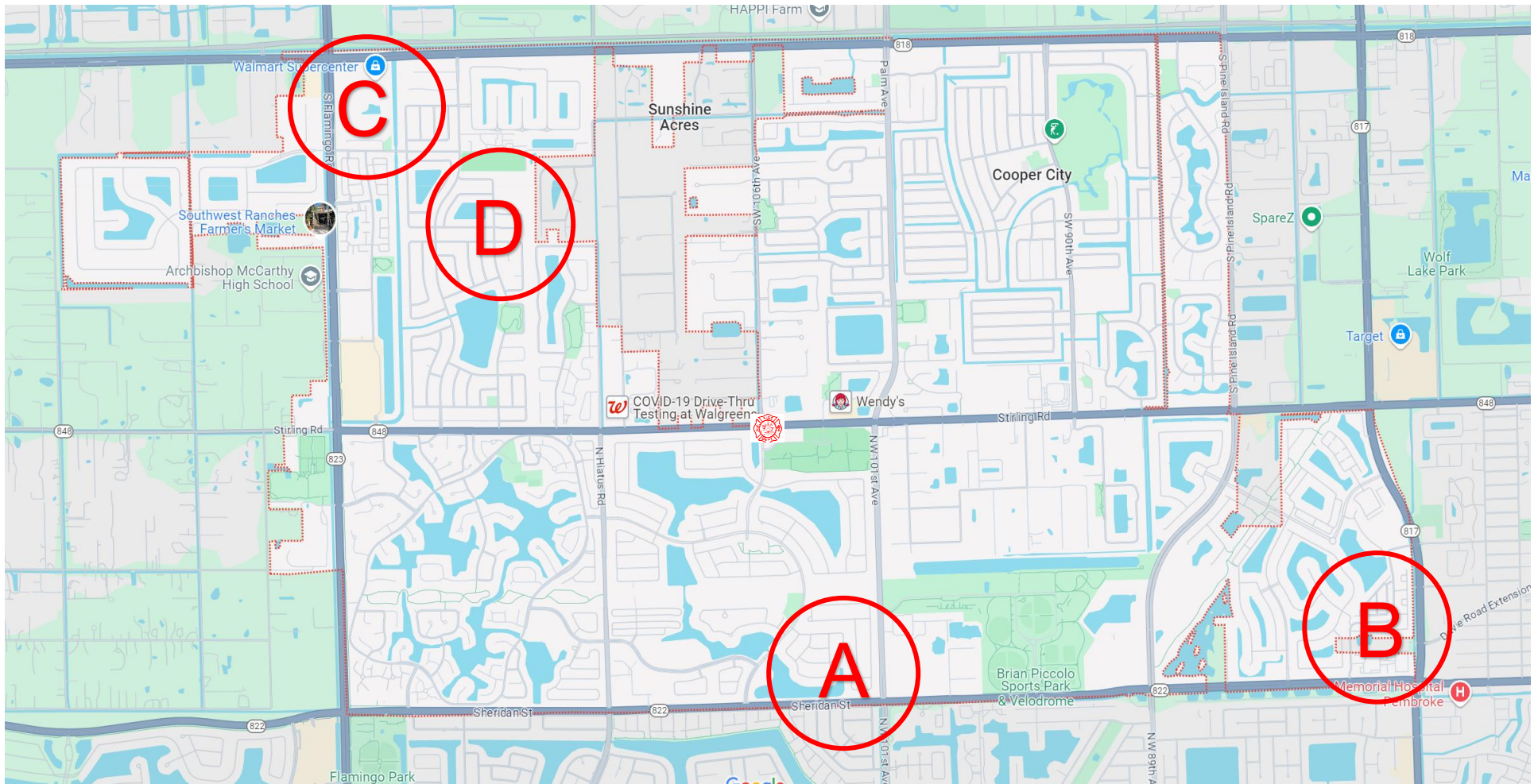
