

RESOLUTION NO. 23-2

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE FIFTH AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT FOR POLICE SERVICES BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF COOPER CITY AND GREGORY TONY, AS SHERIFF OF BROWARD COUNTY, ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT “A” AND INCORPORATED HEREIN; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTION NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on or about October 1, 2020, the City of Cooper City (the “City”) contracted with the Sheriff of Broward County (the “Sheriff”) to provide law enforcement services to the City; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to further maximize the public safety services provided to the City residents, the City Commission seeks to amend its contract with the Sheriff to provide for one additional sergeant to staff the City’s real-time crime center; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that amending its contract with the Sheriff to provide for one additional sergeant is in the best interests of the City and will protect the health, safety and welfare of its citizens and residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA:

Section 1: Recitals Adopted. That each of the above stated recitals is hereby adopted and confirmed. All exhibits attached hereto and incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

Section 2: That the Fifth Amendment to the Agreement for Police Services by and between the City of Cooper City and Gregory Tony, as the Sheriff of Broward County, attached hereto as Exhibit “A,” is hereby approved.

Section 3. That the appropriate City officials are authorized and directed to take any and all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.

Section 4. Conflicts. All resolutions inconsistent or in conflict herewith shall be and are hereby repealed insofar as there is conflict or inconsistency.

Section 5. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and adoption by the City Commission.
