

**RESOLUTION NO. 26-10**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURSUE AND EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH BROWARD COUNTY FOR THE SURTAX MUNICIPAL REHABILITATION AND MAINTENANCE PROJECTS AND MICRO-TRANSIT GRANT PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE GRANT FUNDING AND TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTION NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on July 22, 2025, the City Commission approved the Third Amendment to the 2025 Amended and Restated Transportation System Surtax Interlocal Agreement (the “Third Amendment”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Third Amendment broadened and streamlined municipal access to Transportation Surtax Revenues using a formula allocation to supplement existing City funding; and

**WHEREAS**, the Third Amendment’s formula allocation each fiscal year is based on the number of Municipal Centerline Miles for each municipality and their corresponding percentage to the total Municipal-owned Roads in Broward County; and

**WHEREAS**, the FY26 FDOT report following the Municipal Centerline Miles distribution of Surtax Funds allocated \$536,396 to the City for FY26; and

**WHEREAS**, the City conducted a pavement study to evaluate the status of roadways to prioritize funding and executing rehabilitation or maintenance on the highest-priority roadways; and

**WHEREAS**, the City intends to pursue surtax-supplemented projects funding in accordance with the Surtax Municipal Rehabilitation and Maintenance Projects and Micro-

Transit Grant Program, including the City’s Roadway Milling and Resurfacing Project to address long-term roadway infrastructure management; and

**WHEREAS**, the Roadway Milling and Resurfacing Project supports the City’s Strategic Priority to maintain and improve the City’s infrastructure and appearance to support and ensure a sustainable and beautiful environment; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission of the City of Cooper City, Florida deems it to be in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the City of Cooper City to authorize the City Manager to pursue and execute a grant agreement with Broward County for the Surtax Municipal Rehabilitation and Maintenance Projects and Micro-Transit Grant Program, consistent with the Third Amendment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, THAT:**

**Section 1.** The foregoing “WHEREAS” clause is hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and is hereby made a specific part of this Resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

**Section 2.** The City Commission of the City of Cooper City, Florida hereby authorizes the City Manager to pursue and execute a grant agreement with Broward County for the Surtax Municipal Rehabilitation and Maintenance Projects and Micro-Transit Grant Program, consistent with the Third Amendment.

**Section 3.** The City Manager, or City Manager’s designee, is hereby authorized and directed to accept the grant funds and to take any and all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.

**Section 4.** All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 5.** If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

**Section 6.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
