SUBJECT: Motion to approve Task Order No. UTL-26-037D under contract RFQ2024-1-PW for Cooper City's Citywide Entrance Monuments, with Kimely-Horn and Associates, Inc., for an amount not to exceed \$299,080.00 to provide professional engineering services. - **Utilities**

CITY MANAGER RECOMMENDATION:

The City Manager recommends that the Commission approve Task Order No. UTL-26-037D under contract RFQ2024-1-PW for Cooper City's Citywide Entrance Monuments with Kimely-Horn and Associates, Inc., to provide professional engineering services for an amount not to exceed \$299,080.00.

BACKGROUND OF ITEM:

The City plans to establish a coordinated system of primary, secondary, and tertiary entrance monuments in accordance with the Cooper City Design Guidelines Manual, adopted on October 22, 2024.

ANALYSIS:

Chen Moore and Associates, along with the City of Cooper City, developed the Landscape Master Plan and Design Guidelines Manual. As part of the Landscape Master Plan, intersections throughout the city were assessed for the installation of monument signs. The installation of these monument signs will require permitting for demolition, electrical, landscape/irrigation, and structural components, depending on location and monument sign selection. The Consultant selected for construction level design will prepare comprehensive entrance monument design packages and provide limited bid-phase services.

The estimated costs presented in the table below represent the anticipated construction cost for each individual monument sign based on 2024 construction industry pricing. Construction of the monument signs is intended to be implemented in phases over multiple fiscal years and will be prioritized in accordance with the Landscape Master Plan (2024), subject to future funding appropriations, Commission approval, and project scheduling considerations. The proposed locations and estimates are listed below.

PROCUREMENT:

Kimely-Horn and Associates, Inc., is one of the consultants awarded under Contract No. RFQ2024-1-PW for Continuing Professional Consulting Services (CCNA). RFQ2024-1-PW was approved at the April 22, 2025, Commission meeting for a five (5) year term, with one (1), five (5) year option to renew. Kimely-Horn and Associates, Inc., was awarded the following category: Civil Engineering.

Pursuant to section 287.055(2)(g) F.S., a consultant selected through the CCNA process can be awarded a "continuing contract" for professional services where each study's amount is not to exceed \$500,000 without any additional competition.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is \$500,000 in the FY26 Approved Budget for this project.
