ORDINANCE NO. 22-<u>5</u>_____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA. AMENDING THE CITY'S CODE OF **ORDINANCES BY AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ENTITLED** "ADMINISTRATION," ARTICLE VII ENTITLED, "FINANCE," BY AMENDING SECTION 2-206, ENTITLED **"APPROPRIATIONS** FOR **OUTSTANDING** PURCHASE **ORDERS:**" PROVIDING FOR THE INCLUSION OF APPROPRIATIONS ROLLED **FORWARD** FROM ONE FISCAL YEAR TO THE NEXT TO BE INCLUDED IN THE SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEAR'S BUDGET; PROVIDING FOR **CONFLICTS: CODIFICATION:** PROVIDING FOR PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 2-206 of the City of Cooper City Code of Ordinances provides for

the administrative carry-over of appropriations from one fiscal year to the next; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to ensure that the City's expenditures and revenues balance each

fiscal year, the City Commission seeks to include any appropriations rolled forward from one fiscal

year to the next in the subsequent fiscal year's budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has held a public hearing in accordance with Florida

law; and

WHEREAS, following proper notice to the public and after having received input and

participation by interested members of the public and staff, the City Commission finds that the adoption this ordinance is in the best interest of the citizens, residents, and business establishments in the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA:

CODING: Words in strike-through type are deletions from existing law; Words in <u>underlined</u> type are additions. Section 1. <u>RECITALS ADOPTED.</u> That each of the above-stated recitals is hereby adopted and confirmed.

Section 2. <u>CHAPTER 2 OF CITY CODE AMENDED.</u> That Section 2-206, entitled "Appropriations for Outstanding Purchase Orders," of Article VII, "Finance" of Chapter 2, entitled "Administration" of the City Code of the City of Cooper City, Florida, is hereby created to read,

as follows:

ARTICLE VII. FINANCE.

Sec. 2-206. Appropriations for outstanding purchase orders.

A duly authorized appropriation of any given fiscal year shall continue to be a valid appropriation of a subsequent fiscal year, without appropriation or inclusion in the later year's budget, providing that the unencumbered balance of each appropriation is reappropriated by the commission in the next annual budget. the expenditure pursuant to such appropriation has been authorized by the city commission or a properly executed purchase order is outstanding at the end of the fiscal year of the original appropriation. Authority to complete such purchase and expenditure is hereby granted and in the event the expenditure is not completed after a reasonable period of time, the city manager is authorized and directed to cancel and close out the unexpended balance of the appropriation. The city manager, or his/her designee, shall provide a report to the city commission in August and in September detailing all duly authorized appropriations that will be rolled forward into the next fiscal year pursuant to this section.

Section 3. It is the intention of the City Commission of the City of Cooper City that the

provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Cooper City, Florida, and that the Sections of this ordinance may be renumbered, re-lettered and the word "Ordinance" may be changed to "Section," "Article" or such other word or phrase in order to accomplish such intention.

<u>Section 4</u>. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

CODING: Words in strike-through type are deletions from existing law; Words in <u>underlined</u> type are additions. <u>Section 5</u>. If any clause, section, or other part or application of this Ordinance shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional or invalid part or application shall be considered as eliminated and so not affecting the validity of the remaining portions or applications remaining in full force and effect.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
