Section 1.05. Advisory Boards.

- (1) City boards. The city commission may, from time to time and as it deems necessary, establish boards to provide advice or recommendations to the city commission or to render decisions on certain matters that may be delegated by the city commission. "Boards" shall include, but not be limited to, committees and task forces.
- (2) General provisions. Members of city boards shall be residents of the city and shall serve without compensation. Subject to Article II, Section 5(a) of the Florida Constitution, no person shall serve simultaneously on more than two (2) city advisory boards.

Such boards, authorities, commissions, agencies and advisory bodies shall be part of the municipal government and shall utilize insofar as practicable the services of the regular departments of the city, under the guidance and supervision of the city manager.
