

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-26

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH EACH OF THE FOLLOWING THIRTEEN (13) FIRMS FOR ARCHITECTURE, GEOTECHNICAL, MECHANICAL / ELECTRICAL / PLUMBING, TRANSPORTATION / TRANSIT, CIVIL ENGINEERING, LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE, WATER / WASTEWATER / STORMWATER AND OTHER: 1) M.C. HARRY & ASSOCIATES, 2) K2M DESIGN, INC., 3) WALTERS ZACKRIA ASSOCIATES, PLLC., 4) OHLSON LAVOIE CORPORATION, 5) CALVIN, GIORDANO & ASSOCIATES, INC., 6) ROBAYANA AND ASSOCIATES, INC., 7) GFA INTERNATIONAL, INC. DBA MILLER LEGG, 12) HAZEN AND SAWYER, 13) CRAVEN, THOMPSON & ASSOCIATES, INC.; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; FURTHER, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Cooper City (“City”) issued a Request for Qualifications under RFQ 2024-1-PW on November 1, 2024, to contract with various qualified consultants, from a wide range of disciplines, to provide general professional engineering services and similar services for various City projects, to comply with the Florida law known as the Consultant’s Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA), Statute 287.055; and

WHEREAS, the RFQ closed on January 21, 2025 and opened on January 24, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the services consist of a wide variety of disciplines, including but not limited to the following general categories: Architecture, Geotechnical, Mechanical/Electrical/Plumbing, Transportation/Transit, Civil Engineering, Landscape Architecture, Water/Wastewater/Stormwater and Other; and

WHEREAS, a Review Committee consisting of the City’s Deputy City Manager, Utilities Director and CIP Manager, met on April 1, 2025 to review and evaluate the 45 submittals (Exhibit “B”); after the evaluation process, the Selection Committee selected twenty five firms to be short-listed. The City Manager selected and recommends thirteen (13) qualified consultants within their

respected disciplines as presented in the matrix attachment, referred to as Exhibit “A” and incorporated by this reference; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA:**

Section 1. That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct, and they are made a specific part of and incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.

Section 2. That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute continuing services agreements between the City of Cooper City and the thirteen (13) consultants which are listed in Exhibit “A”.

Section 3. That the funding for these services shall be subject to and made within the annual budget appropriations and in accordance with City ordinance and purchase policy procedures.

Section 4. Any individual work order of \$20,000 or higher will be authorized by the City Commission.

Section 5. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. That this Resolution shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
