WHEREAS, on August 27, 2024, the City Commission approved Policy No. 02-009 (the "Policy") related to employee sick leave; and

WHEREAS, at the recommendation of the City's employee advisory committee, the City Commission seeks to revise the Policy to distinguish a paid time off policy between those employees hired before and after June 1, 2025, as more particularly described in Exhibit "A;" and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of Cooper City finds that adopting the amended policy, attached hereto as Exhibit "A," is in the best interests of the City's citizens and residents of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are made a specific part of this Resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and expressly made a part of this Resolution.

Section 2: The City Commission of the City of Cooper City, in accordance with Section 4.01(4)(M) of the City Charter, hereby approves the amended Policy No. 02-009, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein.

Section 3: All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4: If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

Section 5: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
