**SUBJECT:** Update on Cooper City's Traffic Calming Pilot Program. – **Commissioner**

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Commissioner Mallozzi requests an update on the Traffic Calming Pilot Program, including progress on the Pilot Program and planned implementations for enhancing road safety in identified areas.

#### **BACKGROUND OF ITEM:**

On December 12, 2023, the Corradino Group presented preliminary findings from a Traffic Calming Study conducted across fifty-one corridor segments. Data collection included speed and volume metrics and a five-year crash analysis. The final report, delivered on February 19, 2024, identified 14 corridors with significant speeding issues.

On May 28, 2024, the Commission approved a Pilot Program for installing temporary speed cushions in nine high-priority corridors. These temporary installations serve as an interim solution while permanent measures are developed. The initiative is designed to gather data for evaluating the effectiveness of these devices in reducing speeds and enhancing safety.
