

Milling & Resurfacing and Master Plan

The Citywide Road Resurfacing project is a multi-year infrastructure initiative aimed at maintaining and extending the life of Cooper City's roads. Guided by a comprehensive Pavement Condition Index (PCI) study, the program prioritizes resurfacing efforts based on each roadway segment's condition. Streets in the poorest condition will be addressed first, followed by those with progressively higher ratings. This data-driven approach ensures efficient resource use, improves ride quality, and enhances safety for motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians alike.
