SUBJECT: Appointments to Senior Advisory Board - Commissioner **Mallozzi**

BACKGROUND OF ITEM:

The Senior Citizens Advisory Board was established by the Cooper City Commission on January 11, 2011, via Resolution No. 11-1-3, to serve as a voice for Cooper City's senior population and to enhance their quality of life. The board advises the City Commission on ways to improve communication, increase senior participation in local events, and expand awareness of issues important to older residents.

By acting as a liaison between residents, neighborhood associations, businesses, and the City, the board helps identify needs and develop recommendations for programs and activities that enrich the lives of Cooper City's senior citizens. It also works with other advisory boards to coordinate efforts that benefit the community as a whole.
