SUBJECT: Laboratory Services Contracts Award

This is a recommendation for Commission approval to award two contracts for laboratory services.

Operation of the City's water system requires constant sampling and testing of our drinking water throughout the treatment plant and distribution system, all the way up to the tap. This allows us to confirm the quality of the water at different stages in the process, and is a requirement of the operating permits issued to us by the State and Broward County. Similarly, we are constantly testing wastewater at various points in the treatment process to ensure proper treatment and compliance with the regulatory requirements associated with wastewater treatment and disposal. Some of these tests are performed by City staff, but many of them require specialized training and equipment, and are more economically performed by a private, certified laboratory.

An Invitation to Bid for lab services was released on June 14, 2018 and five bids were received on July 18 but three were deemed non-responsive. Due to the lack of responsive bids and the large price difference between the two responsive ones, all bids were rejected and a second bid was released on August 16, 2018. Five bids were received on September 12, with one marked as "no-bid". Of the four remaining, the lowest total bid was submitted by Advanced Environmental Laboratories at \$42,463. The next low bidder, Pace Analytical Services, was only \$1,175.50 higher at \$43,638.50 and, in fact, offered a lower price for 87 of the 103 lab tests specified in the bid. A copy of the bid tabulation is attached.

In order to ensure the availability of reliable and quality services, I recommend Commission approval of a three-year contract, with provisions to renew for two additional one-year periods, to both Advanced Environmental Laboratories as the primary vendor and Pace Analytical Services as the secondary vendor. The actual amount of funds spent on laboratory services will be based on regulatory requirements and the approved budget for each fiscal year.

AGREEMENT AMENDMENT #1
BETWEEN THE
CITY OF COOPER CITY
AND
ADVANCED ENVIRONMENTAL LABORATORIES, INC.

The City of Cooper City, a municipal corporation, with principal offices located at 9090 SW 50 Place, Cooper City, FL 33328 (CITY), and Advanced Environmental Laboratories, Inc., located at 10200 USA Today Way, Miramar, FL 33025 (the "Contractor") agree to amend the original Agreement dated October 10, 2018 to provide laboratory testing services to our Utilities Department pursuant to solicitation number ITB 2018-11-UTL.

1. Pursuant to the terms of Section 5, Scope of Work/Technical Specifications, the original Agreement dated October 10, 2018, between the City and Advanced Environmental Laboratories, Inc. and in recognition of satisfactory performance under the current term of the Agreement, the CITY hereby exercises its rights to enter into the first of two (2) 1-year renewal options of the Agreement for the term October 10, 2021 through October 9, 2022, and Contractor agrees to such renewal.

2. Section 3, entitled "General Conditions", set forth in the ITB, is hereby revised and amended to include subsections 3.45 and 3.46, as set forth below:

3.45 SCRUTINIZED COMPANIES -- 287.135 AND 215.473

SCRUTINIZED COMPANIES. CONTRACTOR certifies that it and any of its affiliates are not scrutinized companies as identified in Section 287.135, F.S. In addition, CONTRACTOR agrees to observe the requirements of Section 287.135, F.S., for applicable sub-agreements entered into for the performance of work under this Agreement. Pursuant to Section 287.135, F.S., the CITY may immediately terminate this Agreement for cause if the CONTRACTOR, its affiliates, or its subcontractors are found to have submitted a false certification; or if the CONTRACTOR, its affiliates, or its subcontractors are placed on any applicable scrutinized companies list or engaged in prohibited contracting activity during the term of the Agreement. As provided in Subsection 287.135(8), F.S., if federal law ceases to authorize these contracting prohibitions then they shall become inoperative.

3.46 E-VERIFY

A. Registration Requirement; Termination. Pursuant to Section 448.095, Florida Statutes, effective January 1, 2021, Contractors, shall register with and use the E-verify system in order to verify the work authorization status of all newly hired employees. Contractor shall register for and utilize the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify System to verify the employment eligibility of:

(i) All persons employed by a Contractor to perform employment duties within Florida during the term of the contract; and

(ii) All persons (including sub vendors/sub consultants/subcontractors) assigned by Contractor to perform work pursuant to the contract with the City of Cooper City. The Contractor acknowledges and agrees that registration and use of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify System during the term of the contract is a condition of the contract with the City of Cooper City; and

(iii) The Contractor shall comply with the provisions of Section 448.095, Fla. Stat., "Employment Eligibility," as amended from time to time. This includes, but is not limited to registration and utilization of the E-Verify System to verify the work authorization status of all newly hired employees. Contractor shall also require all subcontractors to provide an affidavit attesting that the subcontractor does not employ, contract with, or subcontract with, an unauthorized alien. The Contractor shall maintain a copy of such affidavit for the duration of the contract. Failure to comply will lead to termination of this Contract, or if a subcontractor knowingly violates the statute, the subcontract must be terminated immediately. Any challenge to termination under this provision must be filed in the Circuit Court no later than twenty (20) calendar days after the date of termination. Termination of this Contract under this Section is not a breach of contract and may not be considered as such. If this contract is terminated for a violation of the statute by the Contractor, the Contractor may not be awarded a public contract for a period of one (1) year after the date of termination.







SECOND AND FINAL AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT
BETWEEN CITY OF COOPER CITY AND
ADVANCED ENVIRONMENTAL LABORATORIES, INC.

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT dated the 1 day of September 2022 by and between:

THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA ("CITY"), a municipal corporation of the State of Florida, with a business address of 9090 SW 50th Place, Cooper City, Florida 33026;

and

ADVANCED ENVIRONMENTAL LABORATORIES, INC. ("CONTRACTOR"), a Florida for profit company, with a business address of 10200 USA Today Way, Miramar, FL 33025.

(CITY and CONTRACTOR may hereinafter be collectively referred to as the "PARTIES").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on October 10, 2018, the PARTIES entered into an AGREEMENT whereby CONTRACTOR agreed to provide laboratory testing services to our Utilities Department pursuant to solicitation number ITB_2018-11-UTL, dated October 10, 2018, (hereinafter referred to as the "Original Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Original Agreement provides for two (2) successive one (1) year renewal periods by mutual agreement of the CITY and CONTRACTOR;

WHEREAS, the Original Agreement was renewed on October 10, 2021, and the current agreement is set to terminate on October 9, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to renew the Original Agreement for the second renewal period of one (1) year from October 10, 2022, and is set to terminate on October 9, 2023.

WHEREAS, the Parties also seek to amend the Original Agreement to ensure compliance with recent amendments to Florida law.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the sum of the mutual covenants and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

Section 1. That the recitations set forth above in the "WHEREAS" clauses of this Agreement are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The Original Agreement is hereby renewed for the second successive renewal period of one (1) year. The renewal term shall commence on October 10, 2022 and shall terminate on October 10, 2023.

Section 3. The Original Agreement is hereby modified and amended to include the following provisions required by Florida law:

E-Verify. CONTRACTOR certifies that it is aware of and complies with the requirements of Section 448.095, Florida Statutes, as may be amended from time to time and briefly described herein below.

Definitions for this Section:

“Contractor” means a person or entity that has entered or is attempting to enter into a contract with a public employer to provide labor, supplies, or services to such employer in exchange for salary, wages, or other remuneration. “Contractor” includes, but is not limited to, CONTRACTOR or consultant.

“Subcontractor” means a person or entity that provides labor, supplies, or services to or for a contractor or another subcontractor in exchange for salary, wages, or other remuneration.

“E-Verify system” means an Internet-based system operated by the United States Department of Homeland Security that allows participating employers to electronically verify the employment eligibility of newly hired employees.

Registration Requirement; Termination:

Pursuant to Section 448.095, Florida Statutes, effective January 1, 2021, Contractors, shall register with and use the E-verify system in order to verify the work authorization status of all newly hired employees. Contractor shall register for and utilize the U.S. Department of Homeland Security’s E-Verify System to verify the employment eligibility of:

All persons employed by a Contractor to perform employment duties within Florida during the term of the contract;

All persons (including subconsultants/subcontractors) assigned by Contractor to perform work pursuant to the contract with the City of Cooper City.
