MINUTES

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Ross opened the meeting at 5:30 PM and led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

ROLL CALL

Present were Commissioners Shrouder, Meltzer, Pulcini, Green and Mayor Ross.

PUBLIC COMMENTS (4 MINUTES)

Marcela White, 11295 SW 55 Pl, spoke on extending the afternoon hours for Forrest Lake Dog Park.

TOPIC FOR DISCUSSION

Motion to approve Change Order with American Pool & Patio, LLC, in the amount of \$19,800 for Pool Coping/Beam Repair & Remediation to the Community Pool at the Pool & Tennis Center **(ARPA Project)**
– **Horace McHugh**

Horace McHugh advised on February 8, 2022 an agreement with American Pool & Patio, LLC, was approved. As a part of the demo of the pool the contractor noticed deficiencies in rebar's and recommended they be repaired to continue the work for the pool. The Building Department was consulted and agreed with the recommendation. The pool company provided the city a change order to repair the pool.

Commissioner Green supports the item.

Mayor Ross asked what will occur if the change order is not approved, can the mar siding continue. Operations Supervisor Tim Fleming answered no it cannot. Mayor Ross said the 20% price increase in high is there anything in the contract that addresses increases. Operations Supervisor Tim Fleming answered these were unforeseen issues.

Commissioner Pulcini asked if anyone in the City can perform the work. Operations Supervisor Tim Fleming answered no. Commissioner Pulcini asked if we can bid out the work. Operations Supervisor Tim Fleming answered a formal bid would take approximately three months.

Operations Supervisor Tim Fleming spoke on the coping system in the pool.

Commissioner Meltzer said he has concerns that more detail did not go into the original RFP. He also asked why the pool company didn't test the pool for possible concerns. RFP's in the future need to encompass these possible needs. He asked how this affects summer camp.

City Manager Napoli advised the Cooper City High School pool cannot be used today as they use it for water polo.

Commissioner Shrouder asked about the warranty on the mar siding. City Manager Napoli advised the mar siding warranty is one year. Commissioner Shrouder read an agenda report approval for the pool resurfacing project approved in 2014 done by the current company. The agenda report stated the company and staff inspected the pool and several areas of concern were addressed and a change order was needed. The same company is being used today and again a change order was submitted. Commissioner Shrouder would like to rebid the project.

Commissioner Meltzer had unease that we knew about concerns in 2014.

Commissioner Shrouder said an inspection was done before the current bid. He has concerns with the same company that performed the work in 2014 knowing the pool conditions has again asked for additional funds for issues. He also advised staff at the Pool and Tennis Center advised him that the company has not been there in weeks to do work. He also has concerns with using the same company as we did in 2014 and the product has not lasted. He would like to rebid the project and use our partnerships with the community for swimming.

Commissioner Meltzer asked the timeline of rebidding. City Manager Napoli advised the scope of work will need to be written and may take up to two months.

Mayor Ross asked about the agreement and paying the current company.

City Attorney Horowitz advised the contract does provide for termination upon 30 days of written notice. The contractor is entitled to be paid for all services rendered up until the date of termination.

City Manager Napoli advised we bid this project out recently with only 2 respondents. The additional work needs to be done and will be required.

Commissioner Shrouder said the company had the opportunity to inspect beforehand and they also had seen the pool before as they worked on the pool in 2014. He also asked about the four week requirement for finishing the pool that was not adhered to.

Mayor Ross said that he understands there will be a delay for the residents and then another company taking on work performed by a prior company can cause issues. He advised of two choices rebidding and waiting months or approve the change order to help get the pool open for residents. He advised summer is approaching and the pool is needed.

Commissioner Meltzer asked if the change order price is definite. He would have thought some inspections would have been performed especially that it is the same company that seen the pool conditions in 2014.

Commissioner Shrouder asked who specifically are we in contract with as there is two names listed on the contract. City Attorney Horowitz answered American Pool & Patio, LLC. Commissioner Shrouder had concerns with two company names written on the contract.

Mayor Ross asked if having the company present to address concerns would help the commission.

Commissioner Shrouder asked that a final job with no change orders and a deadline be established.

City Manager Napoli advised there will be a deadline.

Commissioner Shrouder wants a deadline in writing.

Horace McHugh spoke on labor costs being negotiated.

City Attorney Horowitz advised a date for completion can be included in the agreement subject to vendor acceptance.

Commissioner Pulcini said the certificate of insurance does not have a waiver of subrogation for workers compensation. He asked that errors be corrected before items are placed on the agenda.

Commissioner Shrouder asked where he would find the contractual language for a deadline. He also asked if a no additional change order clause can be added.

Commissioner Green advised in order to have a negotiated agreement the other party needs to agree. He asked if a representative from the company can be present at the next commission meeting.

City Manager Napoli advised staff can negotiate a timeline with the vendor and bring back an agreement on April 12, 2022.

Commissioner Shrouder read a letter in the backup pertaining to removing the gutter wall.

Commissioner Green asked the City Attorney if we can vote on the item given the issue raised by Commissioner Pulcini.

City Attorney Horowitz asked that the Commission redefine the motion to state approval is subject to adding language to insure there are no additional change orders or price increases, incorporating a time for completion and incorporating a waiver of subrogation.

MOTION: Commissioner Green moved to approve Change Order with American Pool & Patio, LLC, in the amount of \$19,800 for Pool Coping/Beam Repair & Remediation to the Community Pool at the Pool & Tennis subject to adding language to insure there are no additional change orders or price increases, incorporating a time for completion and incorporating a waiver of subrogation. Mayor Ross seconded the motion that failed by the following roll call vote.

NO: Commissioner's Shrouder, Meltzer and Pulcini

YES: Commissioner Green and Mayor Ross

Consensus was that the item be placed on the April 12, 2022 agenda and have the vendor present at meeting. All three items, adding language to insure there are no additional change orders or price increases, incorporating a time for completion and incorporating a waiver of subrogation need to be included.

Discussion and possible action on steps to implement the 2022-2027 Strategic Plan

City Manager Napoli advised he has a presentation to be heard and emphasized no decision has been made on any item. A path forward is needed to develop concepts and present options. The presentation is a framework for major elements. City Manager Napoli advised a strategic plan assesses the current environment, establishes future goals and targets, helps set organizational goals and helps develop the strategies to achieve goals. The benefits of a strategic plan include driving the annual operational budget, driving the organizational alignment, helping focus efforts, balance and prioritize resources and leverage resources. BerryDunn was engaged by the Commission on April 27, 2021. Several vision meetings were conducted. A social pinpoint site was opened to provide opportunities for input from stakeholders. BerryDunn met with the internal Steering Committee and draft plans were presented to the Commission. Potential focus areas are the city center concept, beautification and revitalization, connectivity and public safety.

Horace McHugh advised the next steps involve developing a consensus on capital needs, developing estimates and identifying funding options. Beautification and revitalization may consider ideas of monument signs, repaving, light pole upgrades, increased tree canopy's and landscape enchantments. Public Safety can include insourcing or alternative providers, equipment, staffing, communication and dispatch and a new fire station. The next steps are to develop project scopes and funding sources. A general obligation bond includes steps as project scope, outreach, a pre-implementation phase and an implementation phase. Recommended next steps include hiring consultants to provide recommendations. The consultant steps should be around 6-8 months and then the results would be brought back to the commission.

Commissioner Pulcini said he hesitates on the City Center idea. He has several questions with regard to location and costs. He advised he as well as residents would like money spent on schools, public safety, parks. He would prefer to use ARPA funds on public safety and the moneys saved can bring the City up to speed. He would not build a building until the city is updated.

City Manager Napoli advised the concept can be provided by a consultant.

Commissioner Meltzer likes the idea of redevelopment with potential new revenue streams.

Commissioner Shrouder advised the survey results lists public safety as number one, second was schools to which we cannot control as a city, and third was a sense of community and belonging. He would support a center to enrich community with a covered sports facility but not leasing out office space. He would support only what the residents are willing to pay for.

Commissioner Green said the City has a lot of events and enhancing the events to include community belonging is what he is interested in. He also spoke on connectivity with technology and enhancing Wi-Fi at public facilities. Revitalization and beautification also needs enhanced throughout the City.

Mayor Ross agrees with Commissioner Shrouder that we cannot enhance schools as it's the School Boards duty.

Commissioner Meltzer said the schools need updates in beautification.

Commissioner Shrouder said the City's strong point is family and togetherness and he would like to centralize children gathering in one center of the city.

Commissioner Meltzer would love to see an area for barbequing, a senior center and a youth center.

City Manager Napoli said an urban planner would gather different concepts that can be implemented.

Commissioner Pulcini said he doesn't want to take away from the fact that Cooper City is a small bedroom community.

Mayor Ross said we have land and an opportunity to obtain more land. He spoke on many ideas and said an urban planner can be utilized to help prosper ideas. He spoke on having a functional City Hall to enhance productivity. He also spoke on electric fire trucks. A city center with connectivity to BSO and parks can be established.

Commissioner Shrouder said we have a lot of services we can centralize in the center of the City. He also spoke on a centralized place for HOA meetings. He would like to have services for children, seniors and everyone in between. However he does not want to spend millions without the residents agreeing to a concept.

Commissioner Pulcini said the residents do not want to change the City they want to improve the City as it is.

Commissioner Green said the urban planner will cost money and he has no issue with that. But he also spoke on the beautification of the City as everyone may not have time to go to the community center. He would like to enhance the places and ideas we have now. He has not heard residents ask for a better place for events.

Commissioner Meltzer said Cooper Square has a gathering place and he spoke to residents who enjoy and use the gathering tables there on the weekend.

Commissioner Shrouder said he wants the residents to decide but we need to have a concept for them to approve.

Mayor Ross said a room with computers for the residents can be helpful.

Commissioner Meltzer said a location with grills for barbequing can be striking to residents.

Commissioner Shrouder said he does not support a bridge but he would like the center to be in the center of the community. He asked what is needed to gather drawings and ideas.

City Manager Napoli advised we would engage with an urban planner and see what they produce based on ideas.

Mayor Ross asked the process of obtaining the urban planner. City Manager Napoli said we would issue a RFP for urban planner services.

Commissioner Shrouder said he would like explanations on connectivity with regard to pathways. City Manager Napoli read the survey results for connectivity.

Commissioner Pulcini said the survey results are not reliable as we gave choices rather than having open questions.

Discussion ensued on shuttle buses and connectivity.

Commissioner Shrouder has no issue having a planner come up with centralized ideas and having the residents vote on the proposed idea.

Commissioner Meltzer and Mayor Ross agreed.

Commissioner Pulcini wants to improve the City the way it is.

Commissioner Green has no issue with the urban planner but wants to fix the pool and the areas already in need.

Consensus was reached for the urban planner to be hired to offer ideas to be presented to the public for a final decision.

Commissioner Meltzer asked about the monument signs. City Manager Napoli advised the Public Works Director is working on the signs. Commissioner Meltzer also spoke on looking at the fences on Palm Ave and looking into tree trimming.

Commissioner Shrouder said we need a central theme across our corridors for landscaping. The city needs a landscape professional. The City could have the commercial centers follow in our uniform theme. He also spoke on streets cleaning.

Commissioner Pulcini asked the City Manager to look into filing our single audit with the federal government and reporting salaries to the state for transparency.

Commissioner Shrouder spoke on the number one need for the residents was determined to be public safety. He advised traffic issues are on the rise. There has recently been a homicide related to traffic and we need to add personnel.

Mayor Ross said technology can help deter issues instead of adding deputies.

Commissioner Meltzer is happy with the real time crime center and advised we need to see the results from the center.

Commissioner Pulcini advised safety and Police and Fire are the primary obligation of the City.

Commissioner Shrouder said under Florida Law a sworn deputy must make an arrest not a technology device. He advised crime and fraud is on the rise and we need add resources as we decreased Police staffing. He also spoke on response time for fire and the delays. He would like to have automatic aid to have rescue services arrive faster to all areas of the City.

Mayor Ross spoke on having a chief who can offer ideas.

Mayor Ross asked the status of the automated aid agreement with the county. City Manager Napoli answered it may be months before the program is implemented. He advised he has spoken to candidates when interviewing for the open position of district chief on reducing response times.

Commissioner Shrouder asked if Davie would be interested in having automatic aid. City Manager Napoli answered Davie is not interested as it will predominately favor Cooper City and not them.

Mayor Ross asked if Davie would be interested in taking over Fire. City Manager Napoli answered they may be open to discussion.

Mayor Ross asked for consensus to have the City Manager speak to Davie about taking over Fire.

Commissioner Shrouder advised he is in favor of anyone who can assist and improve response time.

Commissioner Green advised he is not supporting allowing the Town of Davie to take over our fire department as in the past it costed more. He does support automatic aid. He also believes there will be challenges if we move to Davie Fire.

Commissioner Shrouder said BSO is spread-out when we need assistance. His concern is response time. We need to improve response time.

Commissioner Green said there will be challenges with response times with any option.

Commissioner Pulcini asked the City Managers opinion. City Manager Napoli advised we do need to address response times particularly in the Monterra area. If there is an option out there it is worth exploring at the least.

Commissioner Pulcini said exploring options gives a negative message to our district.

Commissioner Shrouder said he just wants to better response times.

Commissioner Meltzer said we need to talk to the County as well.

Mayor Ross said the issue is location not personnel.

Commissioner Shrouder said he would like to talk to stations that are closest to us.

Consensus was reached for the City Manager to speak to Davie about possibly taking over Fire to address response time concerns.
