JOB SUMMARY

To operate medium and heavy power-driven equipment requiring a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) (such as excavators, road-graders, knuckle boom trucktrucks, concrete planer planers, forklifts, backhoes, and other various construction-related equipment), assist with the maintenance and upkeep streets, rights-of-way, parks, tree canopy, irrigation system, horticulture, and other City property. Acts as a lead worker on a crew; and to perform other maintenance related and performs other maintenance-related duties as assigned.

This is the advanced journey-level class in the Street Maintenance series. -This class is distinguished from the Street Maintenance. Il by the level of responsibility assumed and the complexity of duties assigned. Employees perform the most difficult and responsible types of duties assigned to classes within this series-including performing duties involved with heavy equipment and the repair and maintenance of streets, drainage system, tree canopy, including performing duties involved with heavy equipment and the repair and maintenance of streets, drainage system, tree canopy, and right of way, with only occasional instruction or assistance as new or unusual situations arise. -Employees in this class are required to be fully trained in all procedures related to assigned area of responsibility. Employees may be required to serve as lead workerworkers over subordinate personnel.

- Perform semi-skilled and skilled work in the operation of the most difficult and complex heavy construction and maintenance equipment, such as compressors, cement mixers, skip loaders, knuckle boom, bucket trucks, and various other equipment, in support of a variety of maintenance and construction activities, including excavating, grading, loading, debris removal and related operations.
- Participate in all required training classes both in the classroom and in the field and practice all safety rules and procedures; exhibit safe movements while operating trucks and equipment.
- Participate in the repair and maintenance of City-owned properties such as parks, streets, roads, alleyways, and/or drainage systems; transport and deliver heavy equipment from construction sites, maintenance facilities, storage yards, and/or other locations as required.

Perform additional grounds maintenance, construction, and maintenance tasks such as reading grades/slope stakes, leveling, surfacing, concrete work, truck driving, asphalt spreading, jack-hammering, excavatinge drainage ditches, and back-fill jobs upon completion and other related tasks.

- Identify equipment needs for each assigned project; maintain records and logs of all work performed, perform pre-trip and post-trip inspections, and perform basic preventative maintenance on equipment as required.
- Install street barricades and cones prior to the performance of street repair activities; direct and control traffic around work sites.
- Communicate effectively with supervisors and others as needed through all methods of communication technology, including but not limited to radios, digital phones, and on board communication devices.
- Respond as needed before/after and during emergencies, weather events, etc. utilizing removal equipment, including front-end loaders, dump truck, knuckle boom, heavy equipment, etc.
- Respond to public inquires in a courteous manner; investigate and respond to complaints from the public; resolve issues in the area of assignment.
- May repair and maintain outside walks, indoor/outdoor lights, fences, driveways, streets, buildings, walls (stucco and drywall), ceilings/roofs, gates, doors (manual and electric), windows/glass, AC/HVAC as well as cut trees, grind stumps, and weed eat.
- Performs other duties as directed.

PHYSICAL/MENTAL DEMANDS

Tasks involve moderate to heavy physical effort, including heavy lifting, carrying, pushing, and pulling equipment or supplies of heavyweight (e.g., up to 50 or more pounds), climbclimbing stairs or ladders, remaining in positions requiring prolonged standing, walking, or sitting. Tasks require physical agility, in which some combination of the following is typically required: bending, kneeling, climbing, crawling, and stooping. Tasks may involve extended periods working in outdoor conditions with exposure to disagreeable environmental conditions, e.g., solar radiation, heat, dust, dirt, humidity, fumes, gases, smoke, acute vibrations, electrical hazards, and confined or elevated workspaces.
