



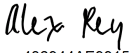

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CITY MANAGER RECOMMENDATION:

Pursuant to the City Commission's approval of the Group Health Insurance through Benecon's (United Health Care) Health Insurance Consortium, the City Manager is submitting the "Florida Local Government Health Insurance Consortium Resolution" for the Commission's approval.

BACKGROUND OF ITEM:

The City's medical insurance renewal with Benecon was approved on August 25th, 2026. Following approval, Benecon submitted documentation for signature by both Benecon and Cooper City. The Florida Local Government Health Insurance Consortium Resolution is one of the documents that must be signed to finalize the agreement between the City and Benecon's Consortium.

The City Attorney has reviewed the resolution and proposed agreement and recommended adding the item to the agenda so the Commission may act on the resolution. The resolution makes specific findings in the City's best interests, and it would be better for the Commission to take action on it.
