V. COMMUNITY OUTREACH REPORT

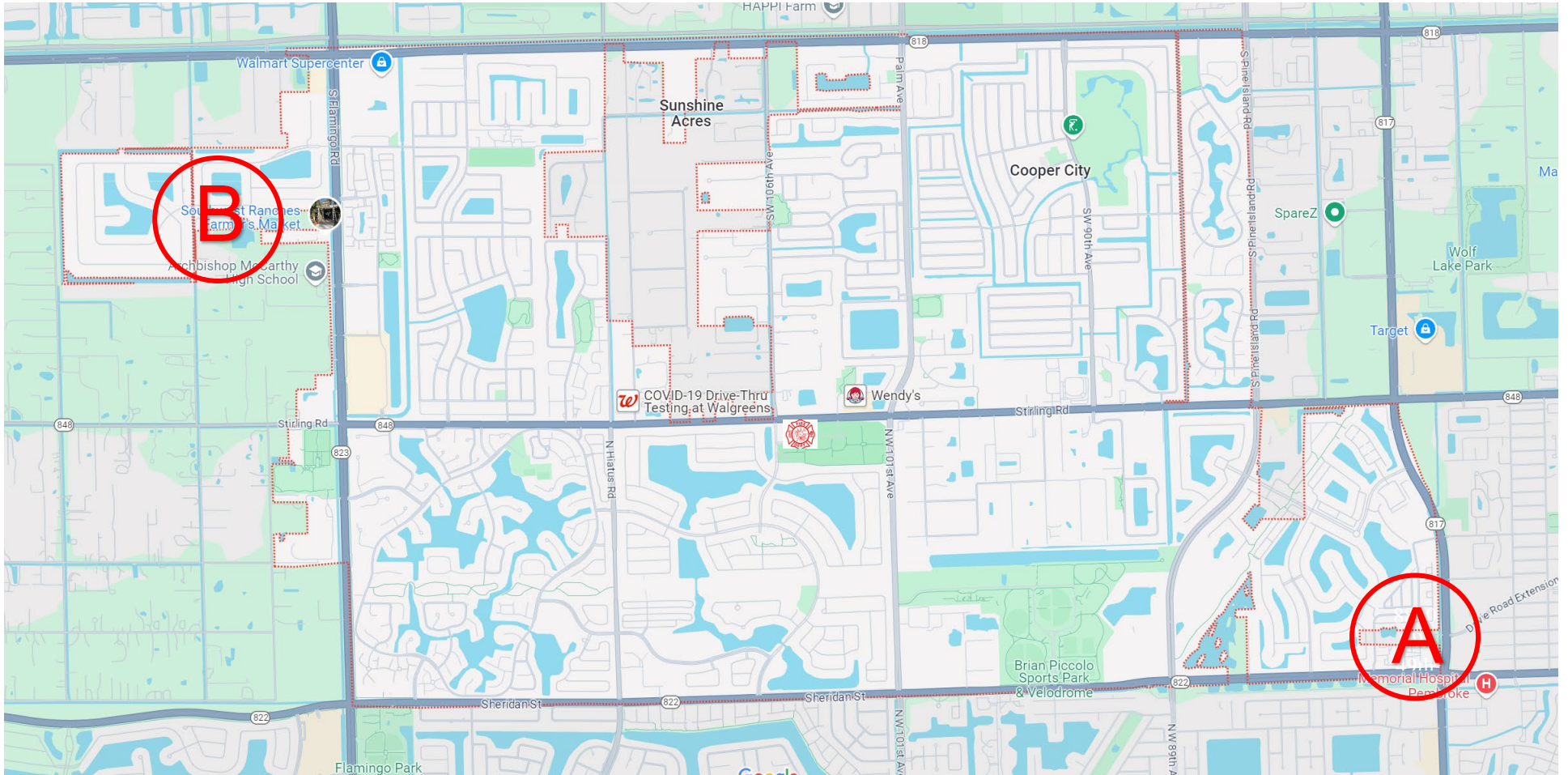
- Life Safety Educators provided life safety information and demonstrations for Cooper City Senior Safety at the Community Center on January 14th.
