TITLE: Ordinance 24-15 (Administration)

DATE: June 11, 2024

DESCRIPTION: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE VI OF THE CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES, ENTITLED "EMPLOYEE BENEFITS;" BY SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 2-156, ENTITLED "GENERAL EMPLOYEES PENSION PLAN;" REQUIRE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE CITY'S GENERAL EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT PLAN TO BE RESIDENTS OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

CITY MANAGER RECOMMENDATION:

The City Manager recommends approval of Ordinance 24-15 on 1st reading, amending Section 2-156 "General Employees Pension Plan," requiring members of the Board of Trustees for the City's General Employees Retirement Plan to be residents of Cooper City.

BACKGROUND OF ITEM:

The City Commission seeks to require that all members of the Board of Trustees who are appointed by the City Manager also be residents of the City.

ANALYSIS:

The City Commission deems it to be in the best interests of the City to require certain persons serving on the Board of Trustees responsible for the effective operation of the City's General Employee Retirement Plan to be residents of the City.
