



**WHEREAS**, April is designated as Autism Awareness Month and Helping Adults with Autism Perform and Excel (HAAPE) is a locally-based nonprofit working to provide meaningful and sustainable employment for the 80-90% of people on the Autism Spectrum who are unemployed or underemployed; and

WHEREAS, It is estimated that over 1,000 families in Cooper City include at least one individual diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD); and

**WHEREAS,** HAAPE is an all-volunteer 501 C 3 nonprofit foundation that creates, funds and sustains education and training programs that lead to employment for adults diagnosed with ASD; and

**WHEREAS**, HAAPE has worked on a unique program with the Broward Public School System ESE Organization to provide training opportunities leading to employment for autistic students and their parents; and

**WHEREAS,** HAAPE fills a void in the community by providing access to a significantly under-utilized pool of talent that is full of creative, energetic, extremely loyal adults with unique skills sets vital to any business; and

**WHEREAS,** HAAPE has estimated that if 5% of the autistic individuals in Cooper City took advantage of HAAPE's training programs and were subsequently employed, the people of Cooper City would save over \$2.5 million per year in ASD-related expenses.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I,** Greg Ross, Mayor of the City of Cooper City, Broward County, Florida, and the City Commission, do hereby designate April 2023 as
