MINUTES

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Ross opened the meeting at 5:30 PM and led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

ROLL CALL

Present were Commissioners Shrouder, Meltzer, Pulcini, Green, and Mayor Ross.

PUBLIC COMMENTS (4 MINUTES)

Pastor Mark Hattabaugh invited the Commission and community to International Holocaust Remembrance Day. It will be held on January 27 at 7:00 P.M. at The Pentecostals of Cooper City on 5201 S. Flamingo Road.

Mayor Ross closed the public comments.

TOPICS FOR DISCUSSION

1. Proclamation for School Choice Week

Mayor Ross read the proclamation, declaring January 23-27, 2022, as School Choice Week. He noted the proclamation will be forwarded to the National School Choice Proclamations Department via the U.S. mail.

2. Proclamation for Reyna Varela

Mayor Ross read the proclamation of service for Reyna Varela. He presented a Cooper City Challenge Ms. Varela and thanked her for her service. Ms. Verala expressed her gratitude to the City.

3. Yard of the Month – Commissioner Shrouder

Commissioner Shrouder presented the Yard of the Month to Carl and Kathie Bradley from District 4. He thanked Florida Nursey Mart for the \$50 gift card. Mrs. Bradley thanked the Commission for the recognition.

4. Recognition of Seagis Property Group, LP – Mayor Ross

Mayor Ross presented the Community Service Award to Seagis Property Group LP for the action they took in advocating for Three Hearts for financial assistance in the form of rent abatement. They thanked the City for the recognition.

5. Certificate of Achievement Alan Miller

Commissioner Meltzer presented a Certificate of Achievement to Alan Miller for his NYC Marathon career. He has completed the marathon 35 times in its 50-year history. Mr. Miller thanked the Commission and noted 80% of his training partners were from Cooper City.

Commissioner Pulcini presented a Certificate of Recognition to Moran Alfasi, the founder of the Holocaust Heroes Worldwide Foundation. She is a third-generation holocaust survivor. The foundation is in the memory of her grandmother, a holocaust survivor. Ms. Alfasi thanked the Commission. She noted South Florida has one of the largest holocaust survivors in the world.
