III. Community Outreach Report

- October 3, 2022, BSO Life Safety Educators and E28 personnel presented a Fire Prevention Public Education event for the Littlest Cowboys age 3 with 24 students

IV. Fire Apparatus/Station Report

- a. Build meetings will be taking place between now and next month with our apparatus committee and the vendor to assure the vehicles are built according to BSO specifications. These meetings will be specifically for the Quint and the Road Rescue vehicles.
- b. ISO inspection has been completed and we are awaiting the report. The assessor states the report usually takes 3-4 months to complete. This report will give us a blueprint to see what areas can be improved upon to provide the best fire rescue services to the community.
