Resolution 22-38 - (Parks and Recreation) TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, APPROVING **DESCRIPTION:** AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE THE YEAR 48 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) AGREEMENT FOR THE SENIOR TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM BETWEEN THE CITY AND BROWARD COUNTY, ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "A" AND INCORPORATED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

CITY MANAGER RECOMMENDATION:

The City Manager recommends approval of Resolution 22-38, approving the agreement between Broward County and the City of Cooper City for the funding of the 48th year Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) for the Senior Transportation Program.

BACKGROUND OF ITEM:

Broward County is a recipient of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Broward County administers these funds, and allocates a portion to be used by the City of Cooper City for the Senior Transportation Program. This program is facilitated through the Parks Recreation Department.

ANALYSIS:

The Community Development Block Grant is in the 48th year of approved funding. The funding for this year occurs from October 1, 2022 – September 30, 2023. The application for submission of the 48th funding year was approved by Commission on March 08, 2022.

STRATEGIC PLAN:

The Senior Transportation Program contributes by providing a Strong Sense of Place, which is identified in the third priority. Having the Senior Transportation Program benefits the senior community for shopping trips, program use, special events, doctors' appointments, etc. This continues to promote and support the social interaction and well-being of Cooper City residents.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Cooper City, Senior Transportation Program, was awarded \$15,000. The Parks and Recreation Department budgets for \$15,000 in kind match for operation of the Senior Transportation Program.
