

**RESOLUTION NO. 26-22**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, DELEGATING TO THE CITY MANAGER THE AUTHORITY TO EXECUTE CERTAIN, LIMITED AMENDMENTS TO THE CITY'S CONTRACTS WITH THE BROWARD SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR POLICE SERVICES AND FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL, FIRE PROTECTION AND FIRE PREVENTION SERVICES; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CERTAIN AMENDMENTS TO THE CITY'S AGREEMENTS WITH THE BROWARD SHERIFF'S OFFICE WHEN DETERMINED BY THE CITY'S PROFESSIONAL STAFF TO BE IN THE CITY'S BEST INTERESTS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on or about September 19, 2025, the City of Cooper City and the Broward Sheriff's Office entered into an agreement for police services and an agreement for emergency medical, fire protection and fire prevention services (collectively, the "BSO Agreements"); and

**WHEREAS**, the BSO police services agreement provides that modifications to staffing shall be within the sole and absolute discretion of the City, and the execution by BSO of a written amendment related to staffing modifications, if necessary, shall be a ministerial function; however, so long as no modifications to staffing which BSO deems essential shall occur without the mutual written consent of both parties; and

**WHEREAS**, from time to time, there are certain administrative recommendations to the City's staffing complement for both BSO Agreements which do not impact the annual budgets of the agreements or change the total number of personnel assigned to the City by BSO; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission seeks to delegate to the City Manager the authority to execute amendments to the BSO Agreements related to staffing, when the City's professional staff determines that it is in the City's best interests to do so, provided that such amendments do not impact the annual budgets of the BSO Agreements or change the total number of BSO personnel assigned to

the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission finds that delegating certain, limited authority to the City Manager, as more particularly described in this resolution, is in the best interests of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COOPER CITY, FLORIDA, THAT:**

**Section 1.** The foregoing “WHEREAS” clause is hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and is hereby made a specific part of this Resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

**Section 2.** The City Commission of the City of Cooper City, Florida hereby delegates to the City Manager the authority to execute certain amendments to the contracts between the City and the Broward Sheriff’s Office for police services and for emergency medical, fire protection and fire prevention services; provided that this delegated authority is limited to those amendments that do not impact the annual budgets of the BSO Agreements and do not alter the staffing complement assigned to the City by the BSO. The City Manager is further authorized to execute certain amendments to the BSO Agreements, pursuant to this delegated authority, when such amendments are determined by the City’s professional staff to be in the City’s best interests.

**Section 3.** The City Manager, or City Manager’s designee, is hereby authorized and directed to take any and all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.

**Section 4.** All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 5.** If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

**Section 6.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
