

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-243

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF U.S. SUBMERGENT TECHNOLOGIES, LLC, FOR CLEANING OF TANKS AT THE CITY'S WATER RECLAMATION FACILITIES FOR A THREE-YEAR TERM, WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW FOR TWO ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR TERMS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE THE GENERAL SERVICES CONTRACT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BID DOCUMENTS AND REJECTING THE BID SUBMITTED BY SUNSHINE ENTERPRISE USA, LLC, AS A NON-RESPONSIVE BIDDER; AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$300,000 FOR THE REMAINDER OF FISCAL YEAR 2023 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXERCISE RENEWAL OPTIONS AND EXPEND FUNDS FOR SERVICES UNDER THE AGREEMENT SUBJECT TO BUDGETED AMOUNTS AND NON-APPROPRIATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, bids were duly called and advertised for utilities cleaning services at the City's Water Reclamation Facilities; and

WHEREAS, bid opening was on April 12, 2023; the Bid Tabulation being attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Utilities Director recommends that the bid submitted by Sunshine Enterprise USA, LLC be rejected as non-responsive in accordance with § 30-82 of the Purchasing Code, because the bid did not conform to bid specifications; and

WHEREAS, the Utilities Director recommends acceptance of the bid submitted by U.S. Submergent Technologies, LLC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. In accordance with § 30-82 of the City Code, the City Commission finds that the bid submitted by the lowest responsive and responsible bidder is the following:

SECTION 2. In accordance with § 30-82 of the City Code, the City Commission rejects the bid submitted by Sunshine Enterprise USA, LLC, as non-responsive.

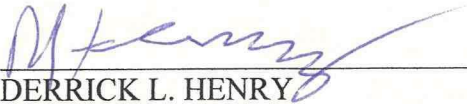
SECTION 3. The bid approved in Section 1 above is hereby accepted subject to the terms and conditions of the bid documents.

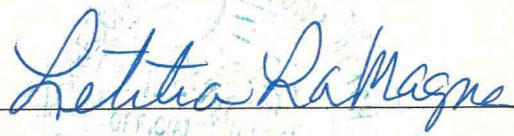
SECTION 5. The City Manager is authorized to exercise the renewal options and expend such sums as budgeted each year, subject to budgeting and non-appropriation.

SECTION 6. The Chief Financial Officer has submitted a Sufficiency of Funds Certificate for expenditures under the Agreement in the amount of \$300,000 for the remainder of this fiscal year, pursuant to Section 46-57(c), City Code.
