Proclamation

WHEREAS, the City of Cooper City recognizes the importance of promoting water safety awareness to protect the health, safety, and well-being of residents and visitors of all ages; and

WHEREAS, drowning remains one of the leading causes of accidental injury and death among children in Florida, and incidents can occur quickly and silently in pools, lakes, canals, and other bodies of water; and

WHEREAS, water-related tragedies are often preventable through education, active supervision, swimming instruction, proper safety barriers, use of life jackets, and emergency preparedness, including CPR training; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cooper City is committed to supporting programs, partnerships, and community outreach efforts that promote safe aquatic recreation and encourage responsible water safety practices; and

WHEREAS, the Parks & Recreation Department, first responders, instructors, and community partners continue to provide valuable education and resources that help reduce water-related accidents and strengthen public awareness; and

WHEREAS, National Water Safety Month serves as an opportunity to remind all residents, parents, caregivers, and organizations of the importance of remaining vigilant around water and taking proactive steps to help keep our community safe; and

WHEREAS, through continued education, community engagement, and safety initiatives, Cooper City strives to foster a culture of awareness and prevention to help protect children and families throughout the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, James Curran, Mayor of Cooper City do hereby proclaim May 2026 as

National Water Safety Month

and urge all communities and citizens of Cooper City to participate in efforts to reduce drowning risk, strengthen families, and protect children and teens.
